

The Severe Weather Network Livingston County has an immediate need for part time seasonal overnight chaperones.

The Severe Weather Network, a 501©(3) nonprofit organization is a Christian based, community-wide, collaborative effort of nonprofit agencies and churches providing emergency, overnight refuge to homeless adult men and women in Livingston County from December 1 through April 18. The Severe Weather Center is operated from a local church and staffed by a Program Coordinator and trained community volunteers.

Hourly pay is \$15.00. There are no benefits with this position. Training is required.

JOB TYPE:

The Overnight Host Chaperone is a seasonal part time position from December 1, 2019 to April 18, 2020.

Duty hours are 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. The team of staff chaperones under the direction of the Program Coordinator will insure there is a staff chaperone on duty 7 days a week, including holidays, with each staff chaperone covering 3-4 days per week.

COMPENSATION:

Hourly pay is \$15.00. There are no benefits offered with this position.
